The scholarship being awarded to you is for the amount of _____ per year and may be renewed for the next four years, provided the required conditions are met. This award is in recognition of the talent and artistic promise you demonstrated at your recent scholarship meeting. Accepting this scholarship award obligates you to participate, as needed, in departmental activities. Each semester, the Art Faculty via classroom observation and scholarship renewal submission will review your progress, and in the event that you fail to meet the specified criteria, your scholarship will be canceled or modified for the following semester. Should you meet the required conditions by the end of each academic year, the Faculty may recommend you to the Vice President of Academic Affairs, who may reinstate your scholarship. The responsibilities required by you as the recipient of this scholarship award are:

- (1) To pursue the prescribed courses toward an Art degree each semester you receive the financial aid your award affords;
- (2) To represent academic work at Limestone College with a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average at all times;
- (3) To maintain a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average each semester for all course work within the art major,
- (4) To represent the Art Department in on and off campus art events and other duties as required by the Art Faculty or its Designate:
 1. Assist in Exhibit installation (hanging, striking, serving and cleaning at openings)
 2. Attend one Visual Arts event per month including a. field trips, b. gallery talks, exhibit openings, c. demonstrations, d. fine arts movie nights, e. or other visual arts activities that broaden your scope as to media, methods, process, idea making, art talk, etc.
 3. Turn in a monthly response as to the visual arts event typed with proper use of art vocabulary. This monthly response is to be emailed to all art faculty: cford@limestone.edu, cnevey@limestone.edu, and yefurd@limestone.edu and will be due at the beginning of each month. The length is half a page or more.
 4. Assist in campus Fine Arts publications such as the Candelabra and bi-semester *Art Department Newsletter*. Your submission to these publications will greatly influence your scholarship recommendations.
 5. Take assigned shifts to keep the Graphics Lab open maintaining departmental rules.
 6. Develop an honors exhibit of exceptional student work hung by students and juried by art faculty. Your participation in such exhibit will greatly influence your scholarship recommendations.
 7. Research and promote "Safe Practices" to better apply EPA standards art processes.
 8. Assist freshmen and sophomores by demonstrating skills, showing your knowledge, using art vocabulary, and setting an example of superior work ethics.
 9. Become a participating member in an active Art Club: *The Haus of Art* to represent the voice of the student artist on campus and assist in promoting the arts amongst the campus/students as well as above-mentioned extracurricular activities.
 10. Work in the studio over and above the class minimum setting an example to others.
