In 2008, Limestone College inaugurated the Honor Band Clinic providing a tremendous service for area middle and high school musicians. In 2014, the newly appointed Director of Bands Dr. Patrick K. Carney recognized a demand for a separate middle school event, and created that event for November that continues to improve, grow and serve our middle school community. Equally, the High School Honor Band Clinic continued and developed into its own reoccurring Spring event. For the past three years, Dr. Carney has brought prominent music educators and conductors to the HSHB Clinic, and now in its 4th year, and 11th overall, the HSHB Clinic provides a wonderful musical experience for high school wind and percussionists.

Dr. Shelby R. Chipman, Director of Bands, Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University

ABOUT OUR GUEST...

DR. SHELBY R. CHIPMAN is Associate Professor and Director of Marching and Pep Bands at Florida A&M University. His responsibilities in the Department of Music include teaching Instrumental Music, Conducting, and coordinating Recitals and Music Interns. Additionally, he assists with administration of the Marching, Symphonic, and Pep bands.

Prior to his appointment at Florida A&M University, he taught band in the Miami-Dade County Public School system for ten years. His band program at Miami Central developed into one of the finest band programs in the country. As much as a teacher as he was a musician, Dr. Chipman was named Teacher of the Year during the 1993-94 school year. Under his leadership the Rocket Marching band performed in the 1993, 1995, and 1997 King Orange Jamboree Parades, 1993 Heritage Festival (New Orleans, LA), 1990-96 Florida A&M University Homecoming Festivals (Tallahassee, FL), 1992-97 MLK Parades & Festival (St. Petersburg, FL), 1997 Macy's Day Parade (New York City), and numerous other marching events. The Symphonic band performed at the prestigious Bands of America National Concert Festival in Indianapolis, IN.

Dr. Chipman is a member of Kappa Kappa Psi Band Fraternity, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Music Fraternity, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Music Educators National Conference (MENC), Florida Music Educators Association (FMEA), Florida Bandmasters Association (FBA), College Band Directors National Conference (CBDNA), FMEA Black Caucus, and Bethel AME Church. He has coordinated numerous band festivals and had the pleasure of working with James Croft, Timothy Reynish, James Suddith, Jim Sparks, Gary Green, Anthony Maiello, and Eugene Corporon, who represent some of the finest conductors in the world. In addition to working with these outstanding conducting, Dr. Chipman has presented music education and conducting clinics on several public school and college campuses, as well as given lectures at the FMEA conference and Mid-West Band & Orchestra Clinic in Chicago, IL. He is an active adjudicator and clinician throughout the Southeastern United States and currently serves as Conductor of the Tallahassee Big Bend Community Orchestra. Dr. Chipman is married to Detrick LaShawn, and together they have one son, Israel Armenian Chipman.

As an educator, Dr. Chipman believes that all students can learn. He believes there are obstacles that create barriers, but through faith, guidance, and love anything can be accomplished. As educators, it is our responsibility to encourage students to maintain their focus. There is good in all and we are challenged to bring out the best in students.

DR. PATRICK K. CARNEY serves as the Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music Education at Limestone College in Gaffney, South Carolina. As Director of Bands, he is the director of the Wind Ensemble, The Limestone Marching Saints, and various chamber ensembles. He teaches instrumental conducting and the music education curriculum for all music education majors.

An active guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator, Dr. Carney has served in these capacities throughout the United States and Southeast Asia. He has conducted wind bands nationally in California, Florida, Georgia, Montana, New York, Ohio, Oregon, South Carolina, and Virginia; and internationally in Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam.

Dr. Carney is an active member of CBDNA and NAFME including the South Carolina Music Educators Association (SCMEA), the Florida Music Educators Association (FMEA) and the SC Band Directors Association (SCBDA). He has served as State Chair (Montana) for the National Association of Bands. He has served as Co-Governor of the Western and Midwest Districts of Kappa Kappa Psi. He is an honorary of Kappa Kappa Psi and Tau Beta Sigma, and a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.
